

What are Dental Implants? Dental implants in Glasgow Scotland

Dental implants are artificial replacement tooth roots that provide a permanent fixed base to secure new teeth. When you compare dental implants to the traditional alternatives (missing teeth, dentures or bridgework) they are the long term gold standard.

Dental implants placed at our Glasgow clinic are an effective long-term solution for people who suffer from missing teeth, failing teeth or long term dental problems.

Why are dental implants so good? Because they fit, feel and function just like natural teeth. We believe dental implants are the future of long term dental care for patients who would have traditionally suffered with dentures.

In a traditional normal clinic, dental implants usually require several visits to surgeons, laboratories and dentists in several locations, and the teeth are created at an off-site lab and shipped to the office. If any adjustments needed to be made, the teeth would need to be shipped back to the lab. At the Berkeley Implant centre, we have combined all of the necessary elements for successful dental implant treatment in a single location. Your consultation, lab work, creation of your teeth, the procedure and recovery are all housed in a single centre.

Peace of Mind

Whilst you are thinking about and considering what a new fixed smile can do for you it's vital to understand what's involved and how it can change your life for the better. Is the procedure painful?

The team at The Berkeley Implant centre are world experts at delivering gentle pain free* dentistry. Depending on what procedure you are having done you can have digitally delivered local anaesthetic or intravenous sedation to make it completely comfortable.

Over 90% of our patients are surprised by how pain free the process can be.



My teeth are really really bad. Am I still a candidate for dental implants?

A lot of people come to us worried that they may not be suitable for dental implants. We are happy to say that over 99% of people that attend our centre are suitable for dental implants. You should know that even age is not necessarily a factor when determining placement position. It doesn't matter if you are missing one tooth or many, dental implants may well be the best solution for you. Unlike normal dental clinics, The Berkeley Implant Centre was created to cater for all patients. Even those with complicated cases. The easiest way to find out if you are suitable is to get in touch, take that first step and come for your consultation.



I want my smile to look perfect for me. Will my teeth look false?

What you need to remember is that dental implants integrate with your own jaw bone so are the closest thing to real teeth. When finished you will be able to brush, floss, eat and speak just like you had real teeth. Our master technician Cameron will be there to ensure we choose the right shape, colour and size of teeth to fit your smile.

Relax in comfort knowing

Our team are experts in explaining the entire process. We will be there to talk you through from start to finish. The more you know the more you can relax. We will always be here to listen and answer any questions.



How long will the healing take?

In the same way that every smile is different, every patient will have a different healing time. If you are having a single implant or just a couple then you can usually use them with soft foods straight away. If you are having a whole new smile then you can sometimes expect some mild swelling and mild discomfort. In this case we will ask you to have a soft food diet for a few weeks to allow the implants to heal fully. After that you can work up to harder foods. Once your final smile is fitted you can eat just like you did before you lost your teeth.



Are Dental Implants at The Berkeley Implant Centre Expensive?

Because we have such precise technology and everything under one roof we can make the cost of expert advanced implants much less than it was even a few years ago. That being said, many of our patients choose to make paying for their implants easier by choosing one of our flexible payment plans. That's why The Berkeley Implant centre works closely with leading healthcare financing companies to provide payment plans for our patients who qualify. During your consultation, our Patient Education Consultant (PEC) will help you work out if financing your new smile makes life easier for you.

How long does the actual full smile in one day take? Can it really be done in just one procedure visit?

The answer to this is yes. The vast majority of our patients walk into the Berkeley Implant centre and walk out the same day with their new smile. To give you a basic idea of what happens read below. You will attend first thing in the morning where you will be gently sedated, the implants will be placed and you will be left to recover and relax whilst watching the TV or a film. At the end of the day your new teeth will be fitted and you will leave with your new smile. 3 to 6 months later we will replace the first smile with your final permanent one.





What pieces make up Dental implants?

Dental implants typically have three parts:

- 1. The implant:** A medical grade titanium screw that serves as a root for your new teeth. This is what permanently attaches to your jaw. WE only use the best implants and the best surgical techniques.
- 2. The abutment:** A permanent connector that attaches to the implant and supports the new implant tooth or teeth. Your dentist is able to remove this for maintenance or replacement.
- 3. The implant crown (or prosthetic tooth):** This is the bit that you see above the gum and in most cases is made from high strength ceramic. We usually use zirconium or lithium disilicate crowns made by our master technician Andrew-Tawse.



What makes our dental implant clinic in Glasgow so special?

Unlike normal dental clinics, The Berkeley Clinic was built to house everything needed to deliver a new implant smile in one day. We have our expert surgical team, our onsite dental lab, the countries most advanced milling machine as well as purpose built “hospital grade” treatment facilities.



With everyone needed to look after you all under one roof we can make the whole process quicker, more efficient and ultimately more cost effective for you.

What can dental implants replace?

At our implant clinic in Glasgow, we use dental implants to replace single teeth, multiple teeth or a full upper and/or lower set of teeth. If you have a full jaw of missing or terminally damaged teeth, then our Berkeley smile in a day procedure may be perfect for you. This technique allows our surgeons to place four implants and then attach a full arch of teeth, giving the procedure its name (all teeth, only four implants).

As dental implants have grown in popularity and technology has advanced, our team of experts have developed one of the worlds most precise procedures for delivering the Berkeley Implant Smile in a day. We all work together under one roof, with a fully equipped, onsite lab, to build beautiful smiles in a way that works for each and every one of our patients.

What is the Berkeley Implant smile in a day at our Glasgow Implant Centre?

The Berkeley Implant Centre Smile in a day is for patients who need to replace a full upper or full lower set of teeth. Our expert surgeon Dr Greig Mclean will place between 4 and 6 implants and then attach a full arch of teeth. At our implant centre we can do this in just one day

Every dental implant procedure begins with a consultation. At this consultation, our surgeon and team create a customized treatment plan just for you, and you will learn exactly how much dental implants will cost you, without having to worry about any surprise fees.



Pre-Procedure Exam

When you have decided that you are ready to move forward with dental implants, you will meet with our master technician and surgeon again, who will finalise your treatment plan and begin to prepare everything you'll need for your procedure. Once this exam is complete, you are ready to schedule your procedure.



Dental Implant Procedure

This is your big day. When you walk out of your procedure, your dental implants will be in place and you'll go home with a temporary set of teeth that look, feel, and function just like natural teeth.



Post Procedure Check Ups

It is important to keep in mind there is a recovery period following your dental implant procedure. Typically patients will be on a soft food diet for several weeks to a few months while their implants heal. During this time, the typical patient will come back in for several checkups to ensure that everything is healing properly. All of your post op checkups are at no additional cost.



Receive Your Permanent Teeth

This is the final step! When your mouth has finished healing and your new dental implants have stabilized, we will replace your temporary teeth with your new permanent teeth.

When would I need multiple dental implants at our Glasgow implant clinic?

Are you missing multiple teeth but still have healthy gums and surrounding teeth? If the answer is yes then multiple implants may be the best option for you. Multiple implants are placed upon which multiple teeth are secured in the form of bridgework or individual crowns.

Occasionally, we see patients who could have multiple implants however, they are very unhappy with the appearance of their remaining teeth. In these cases they quite often choose our Berkeley smile in a day procedure.

What are Single Tooth Implants?

Are you missing a single tooth? At our Glasgow implant clinic we see a lot of patients who have lost a single tooth, quite often it has been lost due to an accident or failed root canal treatment. If you have lost a single tooth we can replace it with a new implant and a beautiful new crown, sometimes in a single visit.




